Materials

- 3 tin cans
- Colour printer
- Light card or photo paper
- PVA glue or similar
- Scissors / cutting knife

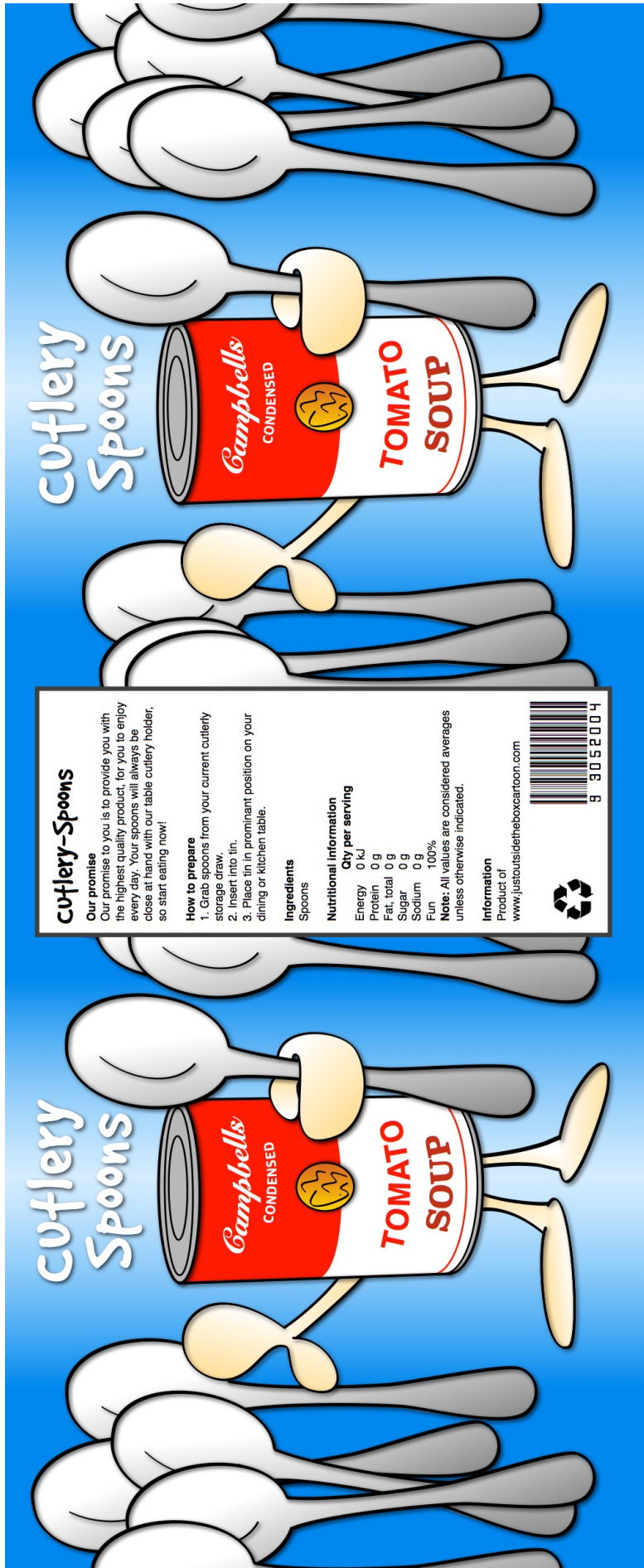
Instructions

1. Print from page 2 onto A4 card/paper. Use borderless setting so print will fit snugly to the height of a standard tin (10.3 cm). I used cheap gloss photo paper for a shiny finish.
2. Cut and glue onto a clean and empty tin can.
3. Place cutlery in tin and display in a prominent position on the kitchen or dining room table.

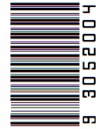
