Materials

- · Colour printer and paper / card
- Glue (optional)
- · Scissors or
- · Cutting knife and ruler

Instructions

- 1. The easiest way to make your memory cards is to print page 2 (the one with the coloured aliens) onto light card and then cut out your cards.
- 2. Alternatively, if you want to have something on the back of each card, then print both pages 2 and 3. Then cut out the two large rectangles making up all the aliens and glue back to back. Use the coloured sheet to cut along the lines to make perfect squares.

How to play

- 1. Place all the cards coloured side down on a flat surface (making a rectangular layout of 4 by 6 works best).
- 2. Each player takes it in turn to flip over two cards. If they match, then they keep the matching pair and immediately have another turn. If they don't match, the next player has a turn. Continue until all cards are paired. The winner is the one with the most pairs.
