

Save the pumpkin this Halloween

Save one, two or three with this three piece design template



Instructions

- 1. **Print from page 2** onto A4 card/paper. Use **borderless** setting so print will fit snuggly to the height of a standard tin (10.3 cm). I used cheap gloss photo paper for a shiny finish.
- 2. Cut and glue onto a clean and empty tin can.
- 3. Once glue has dried, use a **hammer** and **nail** to pierce in some tiny holes that outline the face. If the paper tears slightly, you might need to touch up the face with the black marker.
- 4. You're now ready to go! Place a candle in the tin and light. Sit back and watch the magic of Halloween begin.

Warning The tin can gets hot very quickly. So be careful when picking it up!



- Black permanent marker




