Christmas fortune cookie fun with greetings and joke

Add a unique touch to Christmas with these fun DIY Christmas fortune cookies



MATERIALS

- Asian take away cardboard containers.
- Ribbon for decorating container.
- Scissors or cutting knife. (Use a circle cutter knife for a perfect circle.).
- Sticky dots or Blu-tack.
- Computer print out of the fortune cookies and take away container label.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Print pages of choice (double sided, long edge so the back matches the front).
2. Cut out each fortune cookie either with scissors or an adjustable circle cutter. (Use the dot in the very centre for placement of pin if circle cutter). Also cut out the fortune messages.
3. Fold circle in half and pinch the centre to make a small 1cm crease.

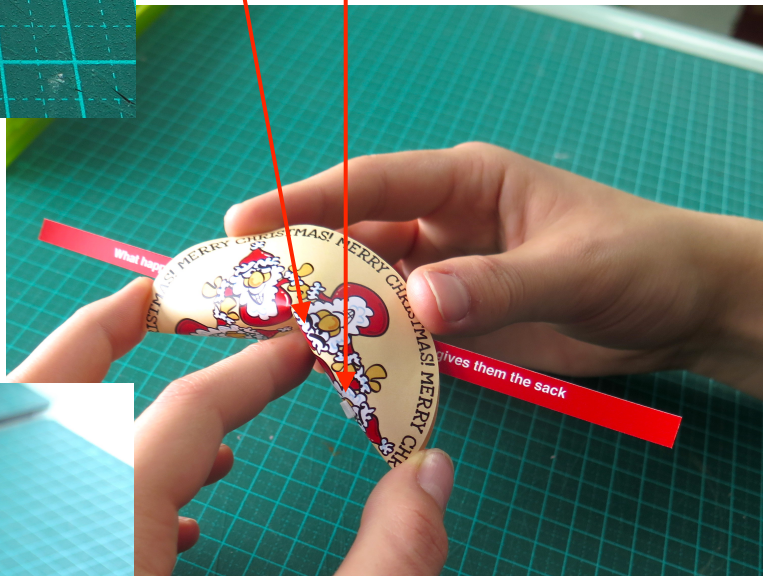


4. Unfold and open to create the full circle. (Note the crease line).

5. Place a double sided sticky dot or small ball of Blu-tack 90 degrees to the crease, about half way down the cracker.

6. Fold cookie in half again and insert a red fortune message.

7. Position fingers as photo, pushing up with the pointer finger and using the crease to help fold the fortune cookie.



8. To make the fortune cookie box, cut out labels for front and back and glue into position.

9. Fill with fortune cookies and close. Add ribbon for a finishing touch.



Print this page and the following double sided, long edge. This should ensure that the front and back align perfectly. Cut out each fortune cookie.
